



BEAUNE 1^{ER} CRU

Les Tuvilains



- *Lieu-dit* : « Les Tuvilains »
- *Varietal* : 100 % pinot noir
- *Year of planting* : 1970, 1984, 2018
- *Terroir* : Very pebbly brown limestone marl
- *Altitude* : 230 meters
- *Exposure* : Southeast
- *Harvesting* : Manual with sorting in the vines
- *Duration of ageing* : 16 – 20 months
- *Cultivation* : Conversion to organic practices began in 2020.



The name “Tuvilains” dates back to the Middle Ages and describes a place where countryfolk work hard on the land.

The Pinot Noir grape thrives on this *premier cru* plot of brown limestone and alluvia at the bottom of the slope alongside the celebrated *climat* of Clos des Avaux. It produces a wine that is all about elegance, a wine rich and sophisticated with floral aromas and wonderful length on the tongue.

Its beautiful silky tannins and lovely minerality offer great ageing potential. It is a balanced, elegant, and concentrated *premier cru* that can be kept for a few years in the cellar.
