



## MEURSAULT

### Vieilles Vignes

- *Lieu-dit* : « Vieilles Vignes »
- *Varietal* : 100 % chardonnay
- *Year of planting* : 1930
- *Terroir* : Clay-limestone on fine gravel
- *Altitude* : 230 meters
- *Exposure* : Southeast
- *Harvesting* : Manual with sorting in the vines
- *Duration of ageing* : 16 - 20 months
- *Cultivation* : Conversion to organic practices began in 2020.



This plot, planted in 1930, is the oldest on the estate. It is located at the bottom of the hillside in the village of Meursault, in the *lieu-dit* of Sous la Velle, meaning “beneath the village”.

These old Chardonnay vines are almost 100-years-old and are planted on clay with a very well-draining subsoil of fine gravel. With low yields, *millerandage*, and small bunches, this Meursault has real structure, and remarkable finesse and richness.

It offers the perfect balance of intensity, fatness and roundness, making it very characteristic of the appellation.
