



POMMARD 1^{ER} CRU

Les Charmots

- *Lieu-dit* : « Les Charmots »
- *Varietal* : 100 % pinot noir
- *Year of planting* : 1982
- *Terroir* : Clay-limestone with iron oxide
- *Altitude* : 285 meters above sea level - 20% slope
- *Exposure* : South
- *Harvesting* : Manual with sorting in the vines
- *Duration of ageing* : 16 – 20 months
- *Cultivation* : Conversion to organic practices began in 2020.



This *premier cru* of Les Charmots is ideally located in the middle of the hillside, on land formerly occupied by large hornbeam trees. This *terroir* faces south and produces the most elegant *premier cru* in the village of Pommard.

These Pinot Noir vines are planted on magnificent red limestone soil full of iron oxide, over a subsoil of Ladoix limestone. They offer rare complexity and remarkable finesse. This warm climate, ideally suited to the Pinot Noir grape, gives rise to a wine of exceptional density, finesse, and elegance.

This *premier cru* has a subtle, airy side. It is a very charming wine that benefits from a few years waiting in the cellar.
