



POMMARD

En Brescul

- *Lieu-dit* : « En Brescul »
- *Varietal* : 100 % pinot noir
- *Year of planting* : 1955, 1980, 1997
- *Terroir* : Clay-limestone
- *Altitude* : 320 meters above sea level – 15 % slope
- *Exposure* : Southeast
- *Harvesting* : Manual with sorting in the vines
- *Duration of ageing* : 16 – 20 months
- *Cultivation* : Conversion to organic practices began in 2020.



Brescul is a superb plot of land neighboring the famous *lieu-dit* of Noizons. It is surrounded by walls, and faces southeast, sitting in the middle of the hillside. In old French, “Brescul” means a plot of vines with a very steep slope.

This vineyard benefits from a cool climate and steeply sloping limestone soil. These are perfect conditions for the cultivation of the Pinot Noir grape.

This famous Pommard *climat* produces rich, concentrated, and powerful wines. In the mouth, it is indulgent and silky. The balance between finesse and structure results in a charming Pinot Noir with beautiful structure and pleasure guaranteed.

This is a wine that should be laid down and treasured for a few years in cellar.
